

# 2020 Swiss PGA Playing Ability Test (PAT)



## **Preamble**

Anyone wishing to start with the Swiss PGA Training Program will have to, beforehand, prove his level of play during an international tournament or an official Swiss Golf Championnat/Championship.

## **Entry Criteria for Swiss Golf Championnat**

- recommended handicap 4.4 for Men and 6.4 for Ladies or lower
- the field of participants is limited, if there are too many registrations, players with higher Hcp will not be considered after date of entry close (regulations Swiss Golf)

## **Entry Criteria for international tournaments**

- according to the entry criteria of the relevant event or Tour

## **Criteria to pass PAT successful**

- minimum of 2 rounds need to be played per event (back tees, stroke play)
- accepted result: **equal or lower than 15 over PAR on total of 2 rounds**
- **all results shall be reviewed by the training commission before accepted as valied**

- ***IMPORTANT: the participant must inform the Swiss PGA office about his planned tournament participation ahead of the event. All results shall be reviewed and approved by the training commission at its sol discretion.***

## **Entry fee**

Entry fee for the tournament must be paid ahead the first round directly to the Club.

## **Exemption**

1. Players who played in national team (girls, boys, ladies or amateurs) within the past 2 years which precede his/her application.
2. "Playing Pros" recognized by the Swiss PGA status.

## **Validity**

The tournament result is valid for a period of 2 years after the respective tournament date. Passed this deadline the candidate has to provide a new PAT result.
